The Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross was awarded to recognise extreme battlefield bravery or successful military leadership. Career Prasch claimed his first two victories on 21 March 1942 over England. Prasch took part in the night fighter campaign against the RAF, claiming eight victories and ten shared. On 30 October 1944, Prasch (then an Unteroffizier) became the first German-born night fighter ace, claiming his first two victories on a night fighter - the Messerschmitt Me 262 in the 9th Staffel. On 1 November, he shot down his third and fourth victories. Prasch, in the 352. Staffel, was awarded the Oakleaves to his Knight's Cross on 4 December 1944 for 240 victories. He claimed his 250th victory on 2 May 1945 over Kassel. Prasch flew his last combat mission on 13 May 1945 in the 352. Staffel. Prasch left the front on 1 June 1945 as a Hauptmann-Wachtmeister and finished the war as a Major. In 1952, Prasch became a professional pilot with Flugstaffel 4 and flew the Focke-Wulf Fw 190. He retired from the Bundeswehr in 1976.
