History AutoCAD is a commercial computer-aided design (CAD) and drafting software application. Developed and marketed by Autodesk, AutoCAD was first released in December 1982 as a desktop app running on microcomputers with internal graphics controllers. Before AutoCAD was introduced, most commercial CAD programs ran on mainframe computers or minicomputers, with each CAD operator (user) working at a separate graphics terminal. AutoCAD Basic AutoCAD Basic was released in 1986 and was based on the earlier PDS-8. It featured a 16-color screen, built-in plotting and editing of forms. It had basic drawing tools, but lacked many of the advanced drafting and editing features of AutoCAD LT or AutoCAD R14. AutoCAD LT AutoCAD LT was released in 1989 as a successor to AutoCAD Basic. It was based on the Fortran IV computer programming language and featured a variety of improvements and additions to its basic capabilities. It has a menu-based interface similar to that of the Apple Macintosh, and it features the ability to draw and edit many items using a 2D image of a 3D model. Autodesk introduced a time-saving feature called Scrub, allowing the user to edit objects through multiple drawings (revisions) without having to re-draw the object. AutoCAD LT 2.0 AutoCAD LT 2.0 was released in 1998 as an upgraded version of AutoCAD LT. It was based on the Fortran V computer programming language and featured a new Windows interface. AutoCAD R14 AutoCAD R14 was released in 2001 as a successor to AutoCAD LT 2.0. It features the ability to perform many of the same functions as AutoCAD LT 2.0, but it is also more feature-rich, and it allows for more sophisticated creation of 3D models. The 2.0 release was the first version of AutoCAD released after Autodesk acquired the previous owners' assets and intellectual property in 2000. The 3D Warehouse is a service with a subscription, and does not offer a free tier. As of 2016, Autodesk offers two subscription plans for 3D Warehouse users, one which allows access to unlimited models, and another which limits access to a set number of models.
